Calvary is doing great in so many areas. The church family must decide to maintain itself as is or move to reach new families. This effort can provide new leadership and a future for the church ministry and ultimately the Kingdom of God.

Case in point: We just completely Vacation Bible School. This involves children. What are we going to do with the young families that represent these children? Will we just talk about a great VBS or we can mobilize to visit these families and make sure we have a place for these children to participate in Bible Study and worship.

For me, it is difficult to visit a young family, because the first question most asked is, What do you have for my children? I want to be able to tell them that we have Bible Study led by regular planned leaders, a Children's worship experience that has at least one person every child sees every Sunday in the Children's Worship experience.

The next stage could be a program on Wednesday nights for children, so parents can attend Bible Study and Prayer Time.

I have come to love you folks, but I'm just can't let my love for you and the comfort zone in which we find ourselves get in the way of your future. Pray, plan to participate in the opportunity to lead the church into a new future.

BUMBLE BEE BALLS

Make these yummy treats as a summer snack.



- 1 cup peanut butter
- 1½ oz. instant oats
- ¼ cup honey
- ½ cup instant milk powder
- ½ cup dark chocolate chips
- 40 mini chocolate chips
- 20 slivered almonds
- 40 sliced almonds
- Adult help Ok

What you do:

- 1. In a bowl, mix peanut butter, oats, honey and instant milk powder into dough. If too dry, add more peanut butter or honey.
- 2. Roll dough into 20 long balls. Place them on a cookie sheet and refrigerate.
- 3. Melt the dark chocolate chips and place them in a zippered baggie. Cut a tiny bit off one corner.
- 4. Remove dough from refrigerator. Squeeze thin lines of chocolate as stripes onto the bee bodies.
- 5. Use two mini chocolate chips for eyes, a slivered almond for a stinger and two sliced almonds as wings. Enjoy!


