I felt it necessary to share my journey in working with Pastor Search Teams. This may help you find some comfort in the work of your Pastor Search Team.

Seeking a Pastor is a lot like seeking a spouse. Differently, of course, but in principle there are many issue that are alike. A Pastor should one that you like for what you see and hear, but also one that you will come to love and support for a LONG time. A lot like a marriage. I guess that's why we call the first year the HONEY MOON TIME.

My experiences have started with a putting my biographical in the hands of a church Pastor Search Team along with others. The PS Team reviewed the potential candidates material and compared the skills, training, age, experience to match as close as possible the Survey taking from the congregation that offered what the congregation would like in a Pastor.

The Team works in confidence because the potential candidate needs to protect his current relationship with his church family. It is important that the Calvary family not know who is being considered until the PS Team announces a candidate for the church to pray over and consider.

The PS Team agrees that all members of the Team must be in agreement on the candidate they have chosen to invite to the church. They should have shared financial plans and agree on a date to move to the Floyd area to Pastor Calvary Baptist, Once the PS Team has agreed on a candidate, a date will be set to have the Pastor and family to:

Preach in a Worship Service

Meet with Deacons for a time of questions and dialogue

Some churches have a meal after the Worship time and have an open forum where the entire church family can ask questions and dialogue with the candidate.

Usually, the PS Team presents the candidate as a motion to vote on the candidate and a secret vote is taken the next Sunday to consider the candidate. The vote percentage is in the Constitution. Should there be a positive vote, a call will be made by the PS Team leader to inform the candidate. The candidate then will choose to accept the vote or decline based on his own personal percentage of the vote.
