Alma Hunt Offering

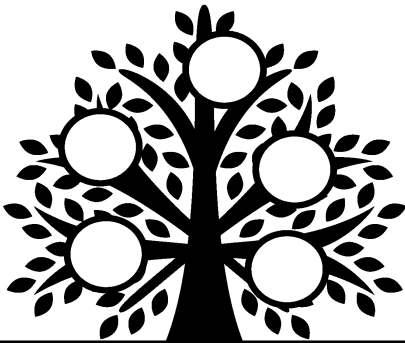

What you do:

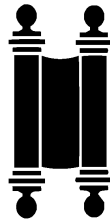
1. Use a cup to trace a circle around faces in the photos. Cut out the circles.

Directions: After filling in the crossword, unscramble the circled letters to complete Psalm 145:4, NIV.

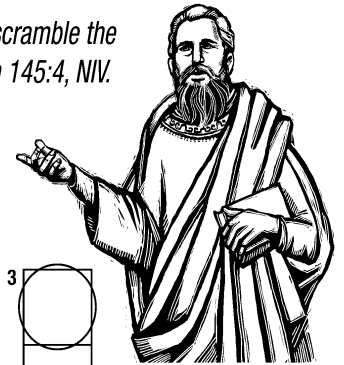
